Present at the event were Senator Serrano, Susan Rosen from the American Red Cross, and Gwendolyn Ryals and Howard Polivy from the Roosevelt Island Emergency Response Team (CERT).

"It is important to educate our communities when it comes to emergency preparedness so that if a disaster does occur, our citizens will be better able to work with our emergency response teams, law enforcement, the fire department, and any agency that may be involved in aid during a time of distress," said Senator Serrano.
