If you would like to make a financial contribution, you can make an unrestricted donation to the International Response Fund at

• Many cellular phone providers have set up a text message system where you can make a \$10 contribution by texting the word "Haiti" to 90999. Your cellular phone company will send you a confirmation text message that you will need to respond to, and the \$10 will be added to your next bill. There will be no cost for the text messages for this service
