included the largely completed renovations the parks' aquatic facility.

Roberto Clemente State Park is a 25-acre water-front park located along the Harlem River in the Bronx. The facilities include a multi-purpose recreation building, an Olympic-size pool complex, ball fields, basketball courts, picnic areas, play-grounds and a waterfront promenade. "Swimmers will be glad to know that the Olympic-sized pool, which has been undergoing renovations, will be ready in time for the Summer season," said Serrano. "Although it took some time to complete, the improvements are dramatic, and I'm certain that the community will be pleased."
