A little taste of what it takes to keep this dinner cooking includes:

- · 10,400 pounds of turkey
- · 2,000 pounds of ham
- · 2,800 pounds of yams
- · 940 pies
- · 625 dozen dinner rolls
- · 48 gallons of cider
- · 19,500 pieces of fruit.
