

Senator Fuschillo Appointed to Senate Finance Committee

Senator Charles Fuschillo (R, Merrick) has been appointed to serve on the powerful Senate Finance Committee by Senate Majority Leader Dean Skelos.

This is the first time that Senator Fuschillo has served on the Senate Finance Committee.

The Senate Finance Committee has a major responsibility to review the Governor's proposed budget, including conducting public hearings and developing the Senate's priorities for the State Budget. The Finance Committee will examine appropriations and disbursements for each agency included in the budget.

The Senate Finance Committee also reviews and considers bills and resolutions that provide for an appropriation of funds. In addition, the Finance Committee acts on nominations sent by the Governor for appointments to many boards, authorities, agencies and commissions, and moving the nominations to the full Senate.
