

Conspicuous Service Cross Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. A current New York State Citizen OR
- 2. A New York State citizen while serving on federal active duty AND
- 3. A current or former full-time military person serving in the Armed Forces of the United States or allied forces for purposes other than training since 1917; Active Guard/Reserve (AGR) excepted AND
- 4. Currently serving under honorable conditions or honorably discharged from active duty.

An individual must be the recipient of at least one of the following:

- 1. Medal of Honor
- 2. Distinguished Service Cross
- 3. Navy Cross
- 4. Air Force Cross
- 5. Defense Distinguished Service Medal
- 6. Distinguished Service Medal (Army)
- 7. Distinguished Service Medal (Navy-Marine Corps)



have been declared by the Department of Defense as killed or missing in action.

NOTE: Acceptable documentation for veterans who served at Pearl Harbor on December 7, 194, is a certified copy of the application form for the Pearl harbor Commemorative Medal or the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association, Inc. membership card.

STANDARD: If you have previously been awarded the NYS Medal for Merit, you are not authorized to receive the NYS Conspicuous Service Cross. All above qualifying awards must have been earned while serving on federal active duty in the Armed Forced of the United States.

Conspicuous Service Star/Medal For Merit Eligibility Criteria:

The general criteria for both awards require an individual to be:

- 1. A current New York State Citizen OR
- 2. A New York State citizen while serving on federal active duty AND
- 3. A current or former full-time military person serving in the Armed Forces of the United States or allied forces for purposes other than training since 1917; Active Guard/Reserve (AGR) excepted AND
- 4. Currently serving under honorable conditions or honorably discharged from active duty.

NOTE: Specifically excluded are the Army Superior Unit Award, Navy "E" Award Ribbon, and the United States Merchant Marine Gallant Ship Citation Ribbon.

STANDARD: If you have previously been awarded or now qualify for the New York State Conspicuous Service Cross, you are not authorized to receive the New York State Medal for Merit.

NOTE: All above qualifying awards must have been earned while serving on federal active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States.
