The three students, Ross Iscowitz, Samantha Finkel, and Jordan Horowitz, are the founders of "Tutors For A Cure." Founded this past January, Tutors For A Cure is a student run organization which offers peer tutoring to students in grades 4 through 12. Student tutors provide assistance in a wide variety of subjects, including english, math, social studies, foreign language, science, and computer skills.

The tutors charge an hourly fee and donate a portion of the proceeds to the American Cancer Society. According to the organizations co-founder, Tutors For A Cure has already donated over \$500 to the American Cancer Society to help fund cancer research and find a cure for cancer.
