


Senator Martins Makes Long Island Press Power List

It hasn't taken long for the former four-term mayor of Mineola to quickly find his way around Albany. After winning an election in the 7th Senate District noted for its long, drawnout recount, Martins unseated the incumbent Democrat, Craig Johnson, and helped cement the Republican majority. With his engaging smile and ready handshake, Martins was popular in his village for being fiscally responsible. But he also became known around the Island for

his innovative thinking regarding downtown revitalization, particularly encouraging affordable housing near the Mineola train station. In the state Senate, he's become indispensable to Majority Leader Dean Skelos (R-Rockville Centre), while also supporting Democratic Gov. Andrew Cuomo's agenda, in particular passing the 2-percent property tax cap and closing the \$10-billion budget deficit without raising taxes.
