Senator José M. Serrano today attended Bronx Pride 2011 in Crotona Park. The event was organized by the Bronx Community Pride Center, which provides much-needed services and programming for LGBT individuals in the borough of the Bronx. As a Marriage Equality advocate, Senator Serrano voted yes on the measure, and is hopeful that other states will follow New York's lead in granting civil rights for all.
