Senator Steve Saland (R, I, C - Poughkeepsie) today announced that the Columbia County Sheriff's Department has received a grant under the Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program in the amount of \$25,000.

"This grant will provide much needed funding to better equip the Sheriff's Department, thereby bolstering the safety of our community without burdening the local property taxpayers."
