I invite all families to participate," said Senator Fuschillo.

Senator Fuschillo's Summertime Reading program is open to all elementary school students in his Senate district. To complete the program, participants must read at least three books and write a brief description of them in a "summer reading journal." Once children fill out their journal and have it signed by a parent, they can send it back to Senator Fuschillo's office to receive an official New York State Senate certificate.
