More than 10,000 seniors in the Senator's district benefit from EPIC, a program which helps low-income seniors with the cost of their prescription drugs. Senator Ritchie was instrumental in restoring funds to EPIC in the past two State Budgets, and reinstating prescription drug co-pays.

"From flu shots to fitness tips, this event is all about giving our area's senior citizens access to organizations promoting healthy living," said Senator Ritchie.

"One of the biggest tools our seniors have to help keep them in good health is EPIC. I'd like to thank Senator Valesky for taking his time to address some of the concerns seniors in Central New York have about this very important prescription drug program."
