Staten Island's Six FEMA Disaster Recovery Centers Open Thanksgiving Day

Staten Island's six FEMA disaster recovery centers will be operating from 8 a.m. to noon on Thanksgiving Day.

The Federal Emergency Management Agency disaster recovery centers (DRCs) include a myriad of services for those who suffered losses during Hurricane Sandy. They include:

- Clarification of any written correspondence received.
- Answers to questions, resolution to problems and referrals to agencies that may provide further assistance.
- Small Business Association (SBA) program information if there is a SBA representative at the particular location.
- Guidance regarding disaster recovery.
- Housing assistance and rental resource information.
- Status of applications being processed by FEMA.
