


Senator Golden Funds a New Van for Bay Ridge Senior Center to Replace Vehicle Totaled in March Collision

But once I knew that there was no major injuries, my mind immediately turned to thinking of how I could help replace this van."

"Ladies and gentleman, this van is for you. This van is so you can travel our community, go on trips, and more. I look forward to being aboard the van for one its first rides," continued Senator Golden.

The terrible car accident happened on Colonial Road at 78th Street and injured 11 seniors and totaled one of the senior center vans on Tuesday, March 26th of this year. None of the injuries were life threatening.
