TO RECEIVE STATE FUNDING

Area Projects Among Winners of Regional Economic Development Council Awards

Senator Robach today announced that 20 job creation projects in the 56th Senate District will receive critically important state funds through the second round of Regional

Economic Development Council awards.

“This is tremendous news because these projects will strengthen our economy and help create and retain jobs,” Senator Robach said. “Our community leaders serving on the regional economic development council have worked hard to put together an economic development strategy that takes advantage of the tremendous resources, skills and talent in our area.
