The challenges are real, and as many will face the prospect of PTSD, this is an opportunity to examine new ways to expand healthcare services, including insurance coverage, for those suffering long after they have returned from combat. We must ensure that anyone diagnosed with autism, including their families, have the vital services and support structure that they need.
