To receive free financial planning advice, you must meet one or more of these eligibility requirements:

• Your home has been significantly impaired or damaged;

- Business owner whose place of business has been significantly impaired;
- Loss of work as a direct result;
- Suffered a direct or indirect financial loss;
- Incurred medical and/or other significant expense (e.g., alternative housing); or
- A family member has been injured or died.

Volunteers will provide advice in the following areas:

- Providing guidance to gain more control over their finances
- Identifying resources for relief assistance (e.g., FEMA, SBA)
- Tips to prevent fraudulent services
- Budgeting / managing increased expenses (e.g., alternative living, clothing, medical)
- Debt management
- Tax relief and guidance
- Estate planning
