My colleagues in the New York State Senate and I recently passed 14 regulatory reform bills as the first

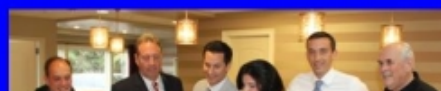
