"This program taught children safety tips to use while riding their bikes, as well as provided free equipment checks to make sure they are as safe as possible. The program provided children with:

- Safety training on a bicycle obstacle course
- Free bike, helmet, brake and tire safety checks
- Information on New York state bicycle & helmet laws
- Instructions on how to use hand signals
- Instructions on sharing the road with cars and pedestrians.

Trained representatives from the New York Coalition for Transportation provided the safety training and conducted the bicycle obstacle course.
