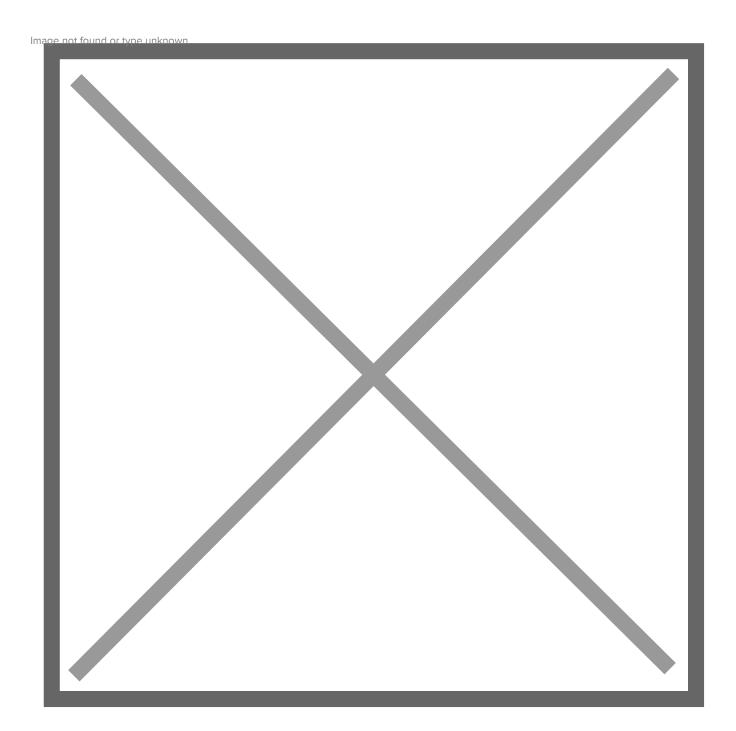


Senator Zeldin Hosts Annual Hispanic Heritage Celebration
