WHO ARE THE REAL EXTREMISTS?

Ladies and Gentlemen, you should know, that recently, our beloved Governor, Andrew Cuomo made some outrageous statements by saying “Who are they? Are they these extreme conservatives who are right-to-life, pro-assault weapon, anti-gay? Is that who they are? Because if that’s who they are and they are the extreme conservatives, they have no place in the State of New York, because that’s not who New Yorkers are.”

With these words, our Governor has created a new class of citizens who are in danger of extermination, a new class of citizens who are in a worse situation and in more need of protection than any undocumented resident of New York State. Talk about “extremist.”

Those tactics include cutting funds from your office budget, cutting office expenses and space, not approving any one of your pieces of legislation, ostracizing you, not inviting you to their meetings and the worst of all, calling you names, laughing and making fun of you because of

your heavy accent, and now making you feel guilty by calling you “Extreme Conservative” and to paint you as a fool because of your beliefs and defense of your faith.

To all those millions of noble and distinguished residents of New York State, Jews, Muslims, Christians and Gentiles who are pro-life and who defend the institution of marriage by opposing same sex marriage, do not allow these threats to make you abandon your faith.
