Senator Boyle Hears Students Thoughts on Common Core

Middle and High School Students gather to discuss Common Core Curriculum

March 5, 2014 - Bay Shore, NY – Discussion on the Common Core Curriculum has dominated headlines of late with every major stakeholder stepping up to make their thoughts known. From parents and teachers; educational groups and administrators and elected officials on both sides of the aisle, everyone has made it a point to weigh in on one side or the other.
