

3rd Annual 'I Love My Park Day' on May 3rd (Updated)

Elmira, N.Y., May 1—State Senator Tom O'Mara (R-C, Big Flats) reminded area residents today that the 3rd Annual "I Love My Park Day" will take place on Saturday, May 3, 2014 at state parks and historic sites across New York, including events at several local sites.

The statewide event, sponsored by Parks & Trails New York (PTNY) in partnership with the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation (OPRHP) and local groups, is aimed at encouraging volunteer efforts to enhance New York's parks and historic sites and promote the entire park system.
