Senate Passes 11 Bills Authored by Senator Andrew Lanza

The New York State Senate gave final passage to the following bills sponsored by Senator Andrew Lanza:

S 2142 LANZA No Same as

New York City

Prohibits expenditure of state, local or public authority moneys relating to federal terrorism trials in the state of New York

S 2298 LANZA Same as A 4966 Cusick

Penal Law

Provides for revocation of probation where a person is convicted of a new offense while such person is under probation supervision for a felony offense

S 2459 LANZA No Same as

Executive Law

Provides that certain sex offenders who are released on parole or sentenced to probation may not enter public, association or free libraries

S 2468 LANZA Same as A 4479 Lentol

Penal Law

Elevates all computer tampering offenses by one degree in severity

S 3600 LANZA No Same as

Criminal Procedure Law

Designates security hospital treatment assistants in the office of mental health as peace officers

S 3606-A LANZA Same as A 4934-A Abbate

General Business Law

Exempts certain officers of the departments of correction and sanitation of the city of New York from training requirements for security guards

S 3981-B LANZA Same as A 5253-B Cusick (MS)

Not-for-Profit Corporation Law

Authorizes certain organizations in N.Y. city to be known as "fire patrols" under the not-for-profit corporation law

S 3983 LANZA Same as A 7169 Cusick

Public Health Law

Directs the department of health to assign at least 1 narcotics investigator to each county in a city having a population of one million or more

S 4165 LANZA Same as A 6166 Cusick (MS)

Correction Law

Requires website providing sex offender registry information to be searchable by the zip code of a registrant's employment

S 4751-B LANZA Same as A 421-C Paulin (MS)

Social Services Law

Expands the persons responsible for reporting cases of suspected child abuse

S 4998 LANZA No Same as

Environmental Conservation Law

Prohibits special assessments on hazardous wastes generated at a brownfield site administered voluntarily by a city, town, village or county
