Unclaimed Funds -

In addition, the Senator Boyle's staff will be available with computers to offer assistance to anyone who is interested in researching the State Comptroller's database where \$13 billion is waiting to be claimed. This could be a financially beneficial service to anyone who has ever:

- Moved without notifying everyone with whom you do business of your new address.
- Opened a savings account and forgot about it.
- Moved without getting your utility deposit refund.
- Forgot to cash a health insurance, security interest or dividend check.
- Left a job and never went back to get your last paycheck.
