



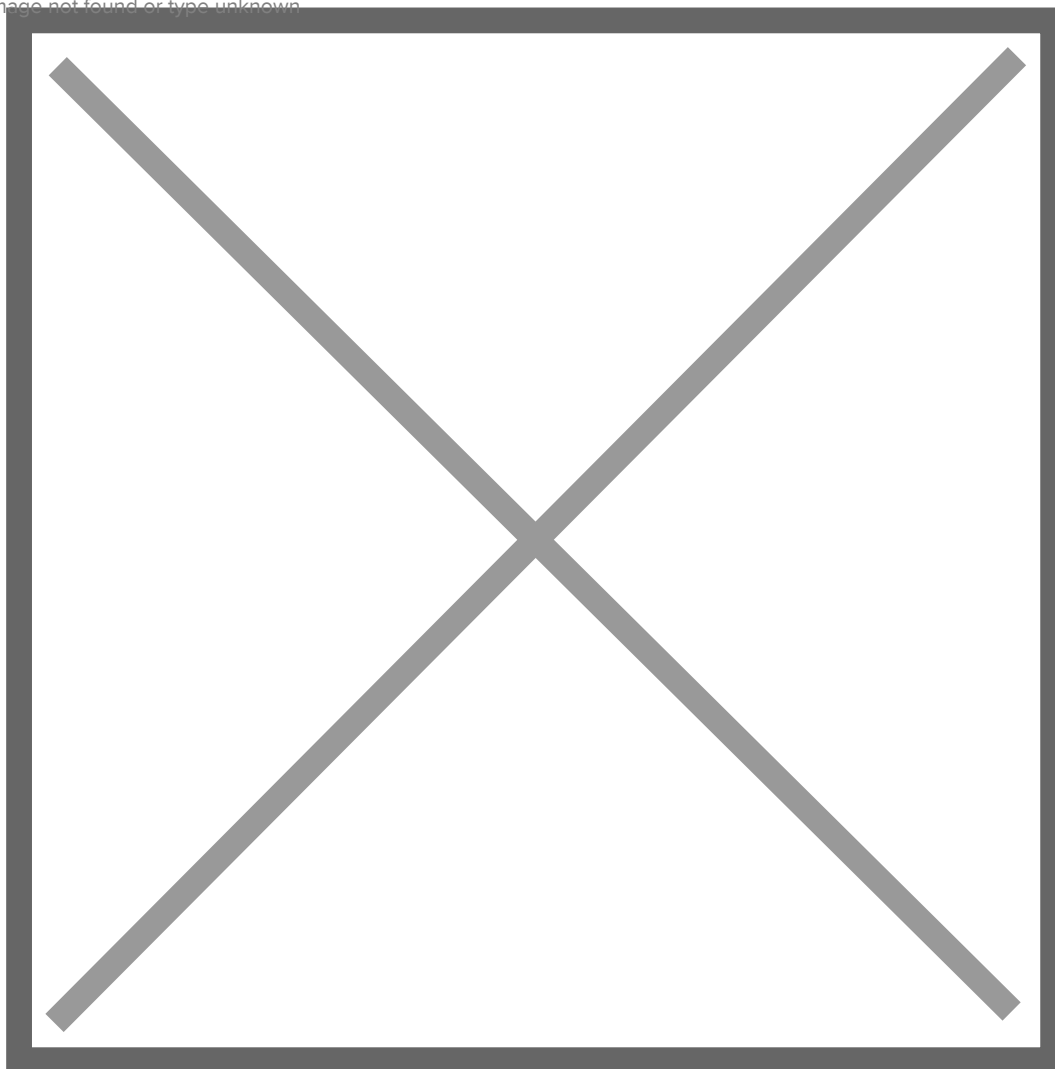

SENATOR GIPSON'S STATEMENT ON RECENT NYS SETTLEMENTS
