Senator Hamilton said, "Our community's investment in that inspirational language arts teacher goes towards educating the next poet laureate. Our tax dollars invested in that

engaging science teacher creates the next generation of biotech researchers and nanotech engineers. Underinvesting in education in our communities deprives New York of the dynamic workforce necessary to compete in the 21st century. What's more, underinvestment in education deprives young people of the opportunity to develop their God-given talents. We insist on sustained, equitable investment in education because when we invest in education, we invest in every New Yorker's future."
