

Statement From Senator Stewart-Cousins Regarding 1199 SEIU Contract Agreement Reached at the Michael Malotz Skilled Nursing Home In Yonkers

Background: Senator Stewart-Cousins intervened this month after negotiations stalled, and urged all sides to return to the bargaining table including St. John's Riverside Hospital (which is selling the facility in Yonkers), Adira Rehabilitation (which is buying the facility) and 1199 SEIU. A news conference was held today, August 21, 2015, by 1199 SEIU to announce the contract details.
