A new funding opportunity was unveiled today in Albany for school districts across the Southern Tier and Finger Lakes regions, and statewide.

According to today's announcement, New York's "Farm to School" program is making \$350,000 in grants available for projects to assist Pre-K through Grade 12 schools.
