

As the Director of the Sullivan County Veterans Service Agency from 1994 to 2000, Mr. Etkin has helped improve the lives of thousands of veterans by providing them with entitlement information and assistance in matters relating to veterans law. Advisory Committee. He has been honored by the American Legion Department of New

York with an Award of Distinction for his leadership with Prisoner of War and Missing in
