Con Edison -

Report service problems and check service status [here](#) or by calling 1-800-75-CONED

MTA -

Check service status of subways, buses, Long Island Railroad, and Metro-North [here](#).

Property Damage -

[Report property damage here](#). This allows the city to report damage to FEMA, which uses the information to assess whether NYC should receive federal funding.

Homeowner's Insurance -

Call the New York State Insurance Department's Disaster Hotline at 1-800-339-1759, Monday through Friday from 8AM to 8PM.
