I was honored to join Lt. Governor Duffy and other local leaders at today's Eastman Business Park community update where we announced an agreement between New York State and Kodak. • Establishes a \$49 million Environmental Trust Fund that will protect current and future purchasers from historic liabilities

- Takes another step towards authorizing Recycled Energy Development in assuming ownership and operating responsibilities for all EBP utilities
- Re-affirms Kodak's commitment to maintaining operations in Eastman Business Park
