Apply for Senior/Disability "Rent Freeze" – Wednesday, September 17

As a result of action taken at the state and local level, the household income cap for New York City's Senior Citizen Rent Increase Exemption (SCRIE) and Disability Rent Increase Exemption (DRIE) programs have been increased to \$50,000.
