Ashley's Law (S.1413) strengthens family ties between New Yorkers who are incarcerated and their loved ones on the "outside." Senator Montgomery introduced this bill in response to a compelling story and request from Ashley Duncan, a young woman whose father was incarcerated. The legislation was signed into law on August 11, 2014.
