State Senator John A. "Our infrastructure in New York state is crumbling," said Senator DeFrancisco. "We now have a windfall through settlements of lawsuits against banks. We should use the state's \$6 billion surplus, a one-shot deal, to help rebuild this deteriorating infrastrucutre, including roads and bridges and sewer and water lines, which will in turn improve public safety, commerce and the overall quality of life."
