(PTSD) -- a program known as the Research & Recognition Project.

I'm equally proud that the Senate this week included funding for the project in our Budget Resolution -- a document that sets the stage for final budget talks with Governor Cuomo and the Assembly leadership.

O'Mara said that he's worked with Bourke over the past several years to help advance and promote the Research & Recognition Project in support of veterans and military families.

I think we have a duty and a responsibility to do whatever is possible to provide our military men and women with treatments that can help them overcome the harrowing effects of PTSD and regain a healthy and productive life.
