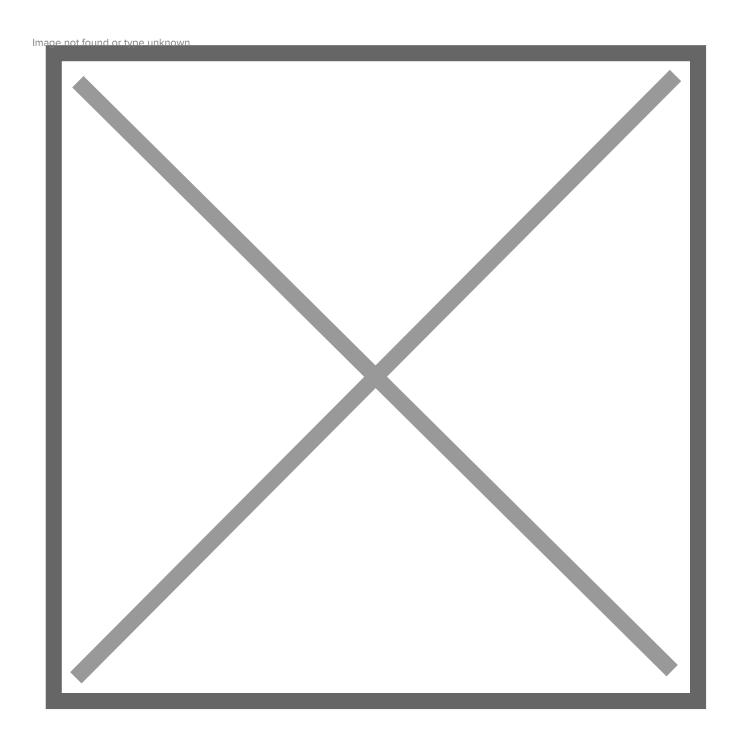


Senator Farley Salutes Fulton County Volunteers
