Public Hearings on Brooklyn's Struggling Schools

The state Department of Education has placed five "struggling" city schools within Senate District 18 into superintendent receivership. Under state law, the schools have two years to make demonstrable improvements in student performance. Public hearings will be held to discuss the performance of the schools, the process of receivership, and to solicit input through public engagement regarding recommendations for improving the schools.
