Senator Farley noted this coming Saturday, Sept. 26th, is National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. It is intended to help protect the environment and public health by ensuring that unused prescription medications are kept out of the wrong hands and are disposed of in an environmentally safe manner. The federal Drug Enforcement Administration has a list of take-back locations in Senator Farley's District that include:
