


FUNKE HOSTS FIRST EVER "HALLOWEEN IN THE HALLWAY" EVENT AT SCHOOL 45

In preparation for Saturday's Halloween holiday, **Funke** also offers families the following tips to enjoy a safe trick-or-treat experience:

- Discard any unwrapped candy or anything that looks questionable or unsafe
- Avoid wearing costumes made of flammable materials
- · After dark, wear light colored clothing or illuminating tape
- Don't burn pumpkin candles unattended, or opt for battery powered candles
- · Place automobiles in the garage, driveway, or backyard if necessary
- Have children trick-or-treat in groups, preferably supervised by an adult
- Use face paint instead of masks to reduce the likelihood of impaired vision
- · Visit only the homes of friends or people in the neighborhood that you know
- Transfer movable outdoor items such as flowerpots to the house or garage
