LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION commemorating the 25th Anniversary of the National Action Network, and recognizing the Annual Martin Luther King, Jr. Day celebration and public policy forum

WHEREAS, Attendant to such concern, and in full accord with its long-standing traditions, this Legislative Body is justly proud to commemorate the 25th Anniversary of the National Action Network, and recognize the Annual Martin Luther King, Jr. Day celebration and public policy forum on Monday, January 18, 2016 at the National Action Network's Headquarters, House of Justice, New York, New York; and

WHEREAS, The theme of the 2016 Martin Luther King Jr. Day celebration is "Breaking the Cycle of Harm: A Non-Violent Response to Gun Violence"; its focus is the tradition of non-violence as well as creating responsible solutions to gun violence and effective gun control laws; and
