WHEREAS, Barbara Weiner has been an asset to the Legal Project by helping it carry out a variety of initiatives which serve the legal needs of the immigrant community; with the support of a grant from the Office of New Americans, she is able to provide consultation and advice to the local immigration population twice a month at the Legal Project; and
