

O'Mara, Palmesano will hold community meetings in Steuben County on Wednesday

Corning, N.Y.—New York State Senator Tom O'Mara (R,C,I-Big Flats) and Assemblyman Phil Palmesano (R,C,I-Corning) today reminded area residents they will hold two community meetings in Steuben County on Wednesday, January 27th.
