WHEREAS, The highest achievement of leadership in Scouting, earned by only five percent of all Boy Scouts, is the distinguished rank of Eagle Scout; and

many years, has lived up to Scouting's ideals and has attained all of the necessary achievements, including completion of a community service project, which was successfully planned, developed and executed; and WHEREAS, For his project, Michael J. Facci raised funds and organized a group of 15 Scouts to install five signs on the campus of St. Rita's Catholic Church in Webster, New York, to help guide newcomers to the facility and planted a garden of flowers to beautify the Church; and WHEREAS, Michael J.
