Veterans from throughout the 48th Senate District—which includes Oswego, Jefferson and parts of St. Lawrence County—are eligible for the honor and can be nominated by veterans' posts, family members, friends and community leaders. All nominations must be submitted by April 25th and all honorees will be recognized at a special ceremony on Thursday, May 12th at the Edick-Hamlick Veterans of Foreign War Post #369 in Mexico, New York.
