WHEREAS, Wilfredo Rosario's energy and willingness to help others has been the cornerstone of his success at the Rescue Mission as well as within the community-at-large, serving as a continuous reminder of what spiritual, social, and physical health looks like at any age; and

WHEREAS, In addition, Wilfredo Rosario is an active volunteer at the Maranatha Church in Rome, and has been helping others in his community by doing chores for elderly neighbors such as mowing lawns and shoveling snow; and
