WHEREAS, Moreover, Jeremy K. Langdale, Jr. camped 54 nights, hiked 25 miles, and volunteered 34.2 service hours; and

WHEREAS, A natural leader, Jeremy K. Langdale, Jr. held several positions including Assistant Patrol Leader, Patrol Leader, and Quartermaster; and

WHEREAS, A graduate of Warwick Valley High School, Warwick, New York, Jeremy K. Langdale, Jr. currently attends Pace University where he is majoring in Adolescent Education with a concentration in History; and

WHEREAS, As a student at Warwick Valley High School, Jeremy K. Langdale, Jr. participated in several musical groups such as the Wind Ensemble, Jazz Band, and Concert Band; a talented actor, he was a member of the Drama Club, and the Performance Company at New York Renaissance Faire; and

WHEREAS, A hard-working athlete, Jeremy K. Langdale, Jr. was a valu-

able part of the Aqua Gems Swim Team and the Renzo Gracie MMA Academy;

WHEREAS, America has achieved her greatest heights of glory through the dedication, determination and tireless efforts of the outstanding citizens of this Nation; and

WHEREAS, It is only with the continued diligence and devotion of our youth, tomorrow's leaders, that America will maintain her glory; and

WHEREAS, The Boy Scouts of America and its members are dedicated to the development of character and leadership in the youth of this Nation; and

WHEREAS, Jeremy K. Langdale, Jr.'s perseverance in rising through the ranks to Eagle Scout is a strong indication of his ability to master difficult tasks; his accomplishment will enable him to emerge as a leader, fully equipped to meet the challenges of today's complex society; and

WHEREAS, This new Eagle Scout is a credit to his family, his school, his community, his State and his Nation, and no doubt his future will be filled with accomplishments of equal importance; now, therefore, be it
