WHEREAS, This Legislative Body is justly proud to commemorate the 50th Annual Long Island Puerto Rican/Hispanic Day Parade, to be held on Sunday, June 5, 2016, and to recognize, with grateful appreciation, the contributions of Puerto Rican culture, as well as those of thousands of Puerto Ricans, to this State and Nation; and

WHEREAS, Organized by the Teatro Experimental Yerbabruja and numerous other organizations, the Long Island Puerto Rican/Hispanic Day Parade is one of Long Island's largest block parties, with tens of thousands of people coming together to celebrate the Hispanic culture; and

WHEREAS, Established in 1966, to develop an appreciation of Puerto Rican culture, the Long Island Puerto Rican/Hispanic Day Parade is a tribute to the unique Puerto Rican heritage and ethnicity and the role its people play in American society; and

WHEREAS, This year's Grand Marshal is Sergio Colon, a respected leader of various Puerto Rican social organizations in both Brentwood and Central Islip, New York; and

WHEREAS, With just pride, this Legislative Body is pleased to recog-
