WHEREAS, This remarkable young man has been the recipient of numerous awards and accolades for his steadfast and unremitting commitment to his community including the 2015 Youth Award by the NAACP of Buffalo, the 2015 Scout of the Year Award by the Boy Scouts of Buffalo, and the 2012 Youth of the Year Award by the St. Martin De Porres Roman Catholic Church; and
