MORE RECREATION ON THE RIVER: RITCHIE SECURES \$50,000 FOR VILLAGE OF ALEXANDRIA PLAYGROUND

In an effort to increase outdoor recreational opportunities in the North Country, State Senator Patty Ritchie has announced she has secured \$50,000 to assist with the cost of a new playground at Scenic View Park in the Village of Alexandria.
